## AN ACT

1	Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
2 3	Consolidated Statutes, in responsible utility customer protection, further providing for definitions, for
4	termination of utility service and for reporting of
5	recipients of public assistance.
6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The definition of "LIHEAP" in section 1403 of
9	Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to

11	§ 1403. Definitions.
12	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
13	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
14	context clearly indicates otherwise:

16	"LIHEAP" or "Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program." A
17	federally funded program that provides financial assistance in
18	the form of cash and crisis grants to low-income households for

home energy bills and is administered by the Department of
[Public Welfare.] <u>Human Services. A LIHEAP application shall be</u>
<u>accepted until all available money is expended.</u>

5 Section 2. Sections 1406(g) and 1413 of Title 66 are amended 6 to read:

7 § 1406. Termination of utility service.

9 (g) Qualification for LIHEAP.--A notice of termination <u>OR A</u> <--10 NOTICE OF A PAST DUE BILL to a customer of a public utility shall be sufficient proof of a crisis for a customer with the 11 12 requisite income level to receive a LIHEAP Crisis Grant from the 13 Department of [Public Welfare] <u>Human Services</u> or its designee as 14 soon as practicable after the date of the notice. Termination of 15 service is not necessary to demonstrate sufficient proof of 16 crisis.

18 § 1413. Reporting of recipients of public assistance.

19 The Department of [Public Welfare] <u>Human Services</u> shall 20 annually provide a city natural gas distribution operation with 21 the listing of recipients of public assistance in a city of the 22 first class. A city natural gas distribution operation shall not 23 use the listing for anything but qualification and continued 24 eligibility for a customer assistance program or LIHEAP. 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
