## AN ACT

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| 7                          | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania   |
| 8                          | hereby enacts as follows:  |
| 9                          | Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  |
| 10                         | as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  |
| 11                         | section to read:   |
| 12                         | Section 1605.2. Voter Registration Efforts(a) A school   |
| 13                         | entity may designate a faculty member to be responsible for  |
| 14                         | voter registration efforts at a senior high school during each   |
| 15                         | school year. A designated faculty member under this subsection   |
| 16                         | shall possess the qualifications listed under 25 Pa.C.S. § 1301  |
| 17                         | (relating to qualifications to register).  |
| 18                         | (b) A school entity designating a faculty member under   |
| 19                         | subsection (a) shall ensure that voter registration efforts are  |

| 1  | nonpartisan in nature. A school entity shall provide the        |
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| 2  | designated faculty member with instructional materials          |
| 3  | concerning voter registration.                                  |
| 4  | (c) A faculty member designated under subsection (a) shall      |
| 5  | nominate a student to aid in voter registration efforts during  |
| 6  | each school year. The student shall be at least 16 years of age |
| 7  | and enrolled in a school entity on a full-time basis.           |
| 8  | (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases    |
| 9  | shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:       |
| 10 | "School entity" shall mean a school district, joint school      |
| 11 | district, private school, intermediate unit, area career and    |
| 12 | technical school, charter school, cyber charter school or       |
| 13 | regional charter school.  |
| 14 | "Voter registration efforts" shall mean the distribution of     |
| 15 | instructional materials concerning voter registration,          |
| 16 | instructions for the submission of completed official voter     |
| 17 | registration applications and official voter registration       |
| 18 | applications to students or employes of a school entity         |
| 19 | possessing the qualifications listed under 25 Pa.C.S. § 1301.   |
| 20 | The term does not include the collection of completed voter     |
| 21 | registration applications by a designated faculty member or     |
| 22 | <u>student nominee.</u>   |
| 23 | Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.               |

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
