- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further 5 providing for suspension and expulsion of pupils. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1318 of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 amended to read: Section 1318. Suspension and Expulsion of Pupils.--(a) Every principal or teacher in charge of a public school may

- 14 temporarily suspend any pupil on account of disobedience or
- misconduct, and any principal or teacher suspending any pupil 15
- 16 shall promptly notify the district superintendent or secretary
- 17 of the board of school directors. The board may, after a proper
- hearing, suspend such child for such time as it may determine, 18
- or may permanently expel him. Such hearings, suspension, or 19
- expulsion may be delegated to a duly authorized committee of the 20

- 1 board, or to a duly qualified hearing examiner, who need not be
- 2 a member of the board, but whose adjudication must be approved
- 3 by the board.
- 4 (b) The board shall review each public school's expulsion
- 5 policies to ensure expelled students do not pose a threat of
- 6 <u>violence or physical harm to other students, faculty, staff or</u>
- 7 themselves.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
