## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in criminal homicide, further
- providing for the offense of drug delivery resulting in
- death.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2506(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 2506. Drug delivery resulting in death.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits a felony of the first
- 11 degree if the person [intentionally administers, dispenses,
- 12 delivers, gives, prescribes, sells [or distributes] any
- 13 controlled substance or counterfeit controlled substance in
- 14 violation of section 13(a)(14) or (30) of the act of April 14,
- 15 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug,
- 16 Device and Cosmetic Act, and another person dies as a result of
- 17 using the substance. For purposes of this subsection, the term
- 18 "sells" means the intentional distribution or sale of a
- 19 controlled substance or counterfeit controlled substance for

- 1 <u>commercial profit.</u>

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
