AN ACT

1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in emergency medical services system,  
3 providing for scholarships for training.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 8112.1. Scholarships for training.

9 (a) Source.--Except as provided under subsection (c), money  
10 transferred under 3 Pa.C.S. § 1113(a)(4) (relating to  
11 disposition of certain funds) shall be utilized by the  
12 department's Bureau of Emergency Medical Services to issue  
13 scholarships to EMS providers who complete EMS training provided  
14 by an approved entity under section 8105(b)(6) (relating to  
15 duties of department).

16 (b) Application.--An individual shall submit an application  
17 for a scholarship to the department on a form approved by the

1 department.

2 (c) Form.--The scholarships shall be in the form of  
3 reimbursement to EMS providers upon successful completion of EMS  
4 training by an approved provider.

5 (d) Administrative costs.--A portion of the money  
6 transferred under 3 Pa.C.S. § 1113(a)(4) may be used by the  
7 Bureau of Emergency Medical Services for administrative costs.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
