6	Section 1. Section 6137 of Title 61 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 6137. Parole power.

10	(g.1) Electronic monitoring devices
11	(1) The board may not release a person on parole who, as
12	a term or condition of the person's parole, is subject to an
13	electronic monitoring device, unless a telephone landline
14	exists and is in operating condition at the dwelling where
15	the eligible offender will reside and the telephone landline
16	will permit the electronic monitoring device to function
17	properly.
18	(2) After a person to whom paragraph (1) applies is
19	released from a correctional institution or county prison, a

1	parole officer shall escort the person from the correctional
2	institution or county prison to a parole office where an
3	electronic monitoring device shall be placed on the person.

5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
