AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for science curriculum to include climate change.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1529. Science Curriculum to Include Climate
- 13 Change. -- (a) Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, each
- 14 <u>school entity shall:</u>
- 15 (1) Provide instruction on climate change in the science
- 16 course of study beginning in elementary school.
- 17 (2) Implement the instruction on climate change in the
- 18 science course of study to align with the Next Generation
- 19 <u>Science Standards</u>.

- 1 (b) The department shall:
- 2 (1) Develop a model climate change science curriculum which
- 3 may include materials from the Next Generation Science Standards
- 4 and make the curriculum available to all school entities and,
- 5 <u>upon request, to nonpublic schools.</u>
- 6 (2) Compile, develop and post on its publicly accessible
- 7 Internet website the model curriculum which may include
- 8 <u>materials already publicly available.</u>
- 9 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 10 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 11 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 <u>"Department." The Department of Education of the</u>
- 13 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 "Nonpublic school." A nonprofit school, other than a school
- 15 <u>entity</u>, wherein a resident of this Commonwealth may legally
- 16 <u>fulfill the compulsory school attendance requirements of this</u>
- 17 act and which meets the requirements of Title VI of the Civil
- 18 Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352, 78 Stat. 241).
- 19 "School entity." A school district, joint school district,
- 20 charter school, regional charter school, cyber charter school,
- 21 intermediate unit or area vocational-technical school.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect September 1, 2020, or
- 23 immediately, whichever is later.
