- § 8201. Definitions. 13
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 16
- "Applicant." An individual who resides in this Commonwealth 17

- 1 and owns or leases a green vehicle and who applies to
- 2 participate in the program.
- 3 "Battery electric vehicle." A motor vehicle that is only
- 4 powered by an electric motor drawing current from a rechargeable
- 5 energy storage system.
- 6 <u>"Commission." The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.</u>
- 7 <u>"Green vehicle."</u> Any of the following:
- 8 (1) Battery electric vehicle.
- 9 <u>(2) Hybrid electric vehicle.</u>
- 10 (3) Plug-in hybrid electric vehicle.
- 11 "Hybrid electric vehicle." A motor vehicle that is powered
- 12 <u>from onboard sources of stored energy that are both an internal</u>
- 13 <u>combustion engine using combustible fuel and a rechargeable</u>
- 14 energy storage system.
- 15 "Plug-in hybrid electric vehicle." A motor vehicle powered
- 16 by an electric motor drawing current from a rechargeable energy
- 17 storage system but also has an onboard combustion engine.
- 18 "Program." The Green Vehicle Pilot Program established under
- 19 section 8202 (relating to program guidelines).
- 20 § 8202. Program guidelines.
- 21 (a) Establishment. -- The Green Vehicle Pilot Program is
- 22 established to incentivize Commonwealth residents to purchase
- 23 green vehicles.
- 24 (b) Form. -- The commission shall develop a form for an
- 25 applicant to complete and submit to the commission after the
- 26 purchase of a green vehicle to participate in the program.
- 27 <u>(c) Submission.--An applicant shall submit a completed form</u>
- 28 under subsection (b) along with a copy of the green vehicle's
- 29 <u>registration to the commission.</u>
- 30 <u>(d) Credit.--</u>

- 1 (1) After the receipt of the information required under 2 subsection (c), the commission shall issue an applicant a credit that shall be used for toll charges on the 3 Pennsylvania Turnpike in the following amounts: 4 (i) One hundred dollars for hybrid electric 5 vehicles. 6 (ii) Two hundred dollars for plug-in hybrid electric 7 8 vehicles. 9 (iii) Two hundred dollars for battery electric vehicles. 10 (2) Only one credit amount under paragraph (1) may be 11 12 issued per applicant. (e) Regulations. -- The commission shall promulgate rules and 13 14 regulations as necessary to effectuate the implementation of the program established under this chapter. 15 § 8203. Expiration.
