## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), entitled "An 1 act creating the Department of Conservation and Natural 2 Resources consisting of certain functions of the Department 3 of Environmental Resources and the Department of Community Affairs; renaming the Department of Environmental Resources 5 as the Department of Environmental Protection; defining the role of the Environmental Quality Board in the Department of 7 Environmental Protection; making changes to responsibilities 8 of the State Conservation Commission and the Department of Agriculture; transferring certain powers and duties to the 10 Department of Health; and repealing inconsistent acts," in 11 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, further 12 providing for fees and charges. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 15 hereby enacts as follows:
- 16 Section 1. Section 314 of the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89,
- 17 No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, is
- amended to read: 18
- 19 Section 314. Fees and charges.
- 20 (a) General rule. -- Whenever the department imposes fees or
- charges for activities, admissions, uses or privileges, 21
- including charges for concessions, at or relating to State 22
- parks, such charges or fees shall be used solely for the

- 1 acquisition, maintenance, operation or administration of the
- 2 State park system and are hereby appropriated for such purposes.
- 3 (b) Parking and admission. -- The department [shall not] may
- 4 adopt or impose [any] charges or fees for parking or general
- 5 admission to [State parks unless the charges were imposed prior
- 6 to January 1, 1995. The department may continue to impose and
- 7 modify parking charges and fees applicable to specific services
- 8 or units within the State park system which were imposed prior
- 9 to January 1, 1995, ] a specific State park in such amounts as
- 10 are necessary to provide for the maintenance, operation or
- 11 administration of that State park and may impose charges or fees
- 12 for admission to and for use of specific services and facilities
- 13 in State parks.
- 14 <u>(c) Powers of department.--</u>The department shall continue to
- 15 exercise the powers previously vested in the Environmental
- 16 Quality Board regarding the imposition of fees and charges for
- 17 State parks and State forests.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
