13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known
15	as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a
16	section to read:
17	Section 822. Report of inventory by health care facility.
18	(a) ReportA health care facility licensed under this
19	chapter shall annually report to the department an inventory of
20	the health care equipment that is maintained in the health care
21	facility. The health care facility shall also report this
22	inventory to the department within 24 hours of the declaration
23	of an emergency, regardless of whether the declaration is due to

1	a natural disaster or public health emergency. For the duration
2	of the emergency, the health care facility shall report its
3	equipment in accordance with department regulations.
4	(b) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "health
5	care equipment" shall mean all of the following:
6	(1) Bed capacity of the health care facility and the
7	number of physical beds in the health care facility.
8	(2) Face masks, gowns, face shields and any other item
9	that is deemed to be personal protection equipment.
10	(3) Ventilators.
11	(4) IV or medical infusion pumps.
12	(5) Cardiac monitors.
13	(6) Any other items required by the department.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
