 Section 8. Lance Corporal Michael G. Plank Memorial Bridge.
 Findings.--

8 (1) Lance Corporal Michael G. Plank was a 2004 graduate
9 of Elkland High School, Tioga County.

10 (2) Lance Corporal Plank served in the Marine Corps
11 assigned to the 7th Engineer Battalion, 1st Marine Logistics
12 Group, Camp Pendleton, California.

13 (3) On June 9, 2010, Lance Corporal Plank died while
14 supporting combat operations in Helmand Province,
15 Afghanistan.

16 (4) Lance Corporal Plank received the National Defense
17 Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Global War on
18 Terrorism Service Medal, the Non-Article 5 ISAF Medal and the
19 Rifle Expert, 2nd Award.

(b) Designation.--The overpass on State Route [49] <u>15</u> over
State Route [15] <u>49</u>, Lawrence Township, Tioga County, is hereby
designated the Lance Corporal Michael G. Plank Memorial Bridge.
(c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
traffic in both directions on the bridge.
