AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 19129, carrying
2 Pennsylvania Route 403 over Yellow Creek in Pine Township,
3 Indiana County, as the PVT George Holuta Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. PVT George Holuta Memorial Bridge.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) George Holuta was born June 9, 1924, in Heilwood,
10 Indiana County.

11 (2) PVT Holuta joined the United States Army on January
12 29, 1943, and served as a Private in the 15th United States
13 Infantry Regiment Medical Detachment during World War II.

14 (3) PVT Holuta was killed in action in Italy on January
15 22, 1944, nearly a year after joining the United States Army.

16 (4) PVT Holuta posthumously received the Purple Heart,
17 World War II Victory Medal, American Campaign Medal, Army
18 Presidential Unit Citation and the Army Good Conduct Medal

1 for his service and sacrifice.

2 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
3 19129, carrying Pennsylvania Route 403 over Yellow Creek in Pine
4 Township, Indiana County, is designated the PVT George Holuta
5 Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
