## AN ACT

18	clear, understandable written policy on sexual harassment and
19	sexual violence that informs victims of their rights under
20	Federal and State law, including the crime victims bill of

2	model policy under subsection (c).

4	(b.1) InvestigationA postsecondary institution shall_
5	investigate an incident of sexual harassment or sexual violence
6	following the timeline established in the policy under
7	subsection (a).
8	(b.2) ProtectionThe sexual harassment and sexual violence
9	policy under subsection (a) shall include protections to be
10	provided to a witness or victim of an incident of sexual
11	harassment or sexual violence while an investigation is ongoing.
