AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for menstruation education.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1555. Menstruation Education.--(a) The following</u>
- 13 apply regarding instruction on menstruation:
- 14 (1) Beginning with school year 2023-2024, each school entity
- 15 may offer instruction on menstruation. The instruction shall be
- 16 integrated into appropriate courses of study in the school
- 17 entity.
- 18 (2) The instruction under paragraph (1) shall be:
- 19 (i) Age appropriate.

- 1 (ii) Medically accurate.
- 2 (iii) Offered to all students, regardless of their gender or
- 3 ability to menstruate.
- 4 (iv) Comprehensive and inclusive of all individuals.
- 5 (3) The following apply to informational materials:
- 6 (i) School entities may utilize any appropriate public or
- 7 private materials, personnel and other resources in developing
- 8 and implementing the program of instruction under paragraph (1).
- 9 <u>(ii) The department shall distribute information about</u>
- 10 appropriate curriculum materials to each school entity.
- 11 (iii) School entities may utilize any curriculum that
- 12 complies with the requirements of this subsection.
- 13 (b) The following apply to curriculum guidelines:
- 14 (1) The department shall develop curriculum guidelines no
- 15 later than twelve (12) months after the effective date of this
- 16 subsection.
- 17 (2) At a minimum, the curriculum quidelines shall include
- 18 the following subjects:
- 19 (i) Information on the menstrual cycle.
- 20 (ii) Premenstrual syndrome and pain management.
- 21 (iii) Menstrual hygiene management.
- 22 (iv) Menstrual disorders.
- 23 (v) Menstrual irregularities.
- 24 (vi) Menopause.
- 25 (vii) Any other relevant topic related to menstruation.
- 26 (3) The department shall consult with the State Board of
- 27 Education and organizations and individuals that provide
- 28 educational expertise and resources related to menstruation to
- 29 develop the curriculum guidelines.
- 30 (4) The curriculum quidelines shall state the minimum amount

- 1 of instruction necessary to adequately educate students on
- 2 menstruation.
- 3 (c) Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, the department
- 4 <u>shall make available to all school entities in-service training</u>
- 5 programs based upon the instruction under subsection (a) and the
- 6 curriculum guidelines established under subsection (b).
- 7 (d) The following apply to professional education:
- 8 (1) Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, each school
- 9 entity providing instruction under subsection (a) shall provide,
- 10 as part of its in-service training, programs on menstruation for
- 11 <u>all instructors whose teaching responsibilities include courses</u>
- 12 of study in which instruction concerning menstruation is
- 13 <u>integrated. A school entity may utilize the programs made</u>
- 14 available by the department or use alternative programs that are
- 15 consistent with the provisions of this section.
- 16 (2) Employes required to complete continuing professional
- 17 education under section 1205.2 shall receive credit toward the
- 18 continuing professional education requirements if the training
- 19 program provided under paragraph (1) has been approved by the
- 20 department.
- 21 (e) The department shall provide the guidelines, in-service
- 22 training and any other materials developed in accordance with
- 23 this section to any nonpublic school within this Commonwealth
- 24 upon receiving a request from the nonpublic school.
- 25 (f) The following words and phrases when used in this
- 26 <u>section shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection</u>
- 27 <u>unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 28 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 29 Commonwealth.
- 30 "Menstruation." The process of discharging blood and other

- 1 materials from the lining of the uterus at intervals of about
- 2 <u>each month from puberty until menopause, except during</u>
- 3 pregnancy, which occurs in individuals who menstruate.
- 4 "School entity." A school district, charter school, regional
- 5 <u>charter school</u>, <u>cyber charter school</u>, <u>intermediate unit or area</u>
- 6 <u>career and technical school.</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
