AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in school directors, further 5 providing for compensation and oath of office. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 321 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended to
- 11 read:
- 12 Section 321. Compensation; Oath of Office.--[All persons
- 13 elected or appointed as school directors shall serve without pay
- 14 except as hereinafter provided.] (a) A person elected or
- 15 <u>appointed as a school director may receive compensation for</u>
- 16 <u>service on behalf of a school district. The following shall</u>
- 17 apply:
- 18 (1) A board of school directors may, by a board resolution
- 19 at a regularly scheduled meeting, authorize compensation for
- 20 persons elected or appointed as school directors.

- 1 (2) Any compensation approved by a board of school directors
- 2 <u>shall be consistent with the compensation limits for individuals</u>
- 3 <u>elected to serve in the municipality in which the school</u>
- 4 <u>district is located</u>, including a member of a local municipal
- 5 board or a local council member. If the school district is
- 6 <u>located in more than one municipality, any compensation approved</u>
- 7 by the board of school directors shall be consistent with the
- 8 <u>median compensation limits for individuals elected to serve in</u>
- 9 each of the municipalities in which the school district is
- 10 located.
- 11 (b) Before entering upon the duties of [their] office, each
- 12 <u>school director</u> shall take and subscribe to the following oath
- 13 or affirmation, which may be administered by any one qualified
- 14 to administer an oath, or as hereinafter provided:--
- I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, obey and
- 16 defend the Constitution of the United States and the
- 17 Constitution of this Commonwealth, and that I will discharge the
- 18 duties of my office with fidelity.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
