AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- related offenses, providing for whistleblower protection and
- further providing for nonapplicability of subchapter.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5557.1. Whistleblower protection.
- 10 An employee of a business, nonprofit entity or government
- 11 entity subject to this subchapter shall be deemed to be an
- 12 employee under the act of December 12, 1986 (P.L.1559, No.169),
- 13 known as the Whistleblower Law, with regard to a good faith
- 14 report of a potential violation of this subchapter. A business,
- 15 nonprofit entity or government entity subject to this act shall
- 16 be deemed to be an employer under the Whistleblower Law with
- 17 regard to a good faith report of a potential violation of this
- 18 subchapter.
