Section 6904(c) of Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 6904. Registration. 9 10 11 (c) Exemption. --12 (1) A distributor shall not be required to register a brand of soil amendment or plant amendment which is already 13 14 registered under this chapter by another person, providing 15 the label does not differ in any material respect. 16 (2) A person shall not be required to pay the 17 registration fee under this section if the product contains a 18 fertilizer and is actively registered under section 6803

(relating to registration of specialty fertilizers).
