5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 24, 1905 (P.L.50,
8	No.35), entitled, "An act to reorganize the Board of Trustees of
9	The Pennsylvania State College," amended June 24, 1939 (P.L.863,
10	No.367), is amended to read:
11	Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That, in addition to the
12	present elective members of the Board of Trustees of The
13	Pennsylvania State College, the said Board shall consist of the
14	following members, to wit: Three members to be elected each
15	year, for a term of three years each, by the alumni of said
16	college; and two members to be appointed each year, for a term
17	of three years each, by the Governor of the Commonwealth, and
18	confirmed by the Senate [; and the following members to serve

ex-officio during their respective terms of office: The Governor
 of the Commonwealth, the President of the College, the State
 Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Secretary of
 Agriculture, and the Secretary of Mines].

(1) The Governor, the Secretary of Education, the Secretary 5 of Agriculture and the Secretary of Conservation and Natural_ 6 7 Resources shall serve ex officio during their respective terms. 8 (2) Board members shall serve as voting members ex officio, except the Governor, who shall serve as a nonvoting member ex 9 10 officio. 11 (3) No person who has served in the capacity of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Auditor General 13 or State Treasurer shall be permitted to serve on the Board of 14 Trustees as a voting member until at least four years have elapsed following his official departure from that office. 15 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read: 16

17 Section 3. [The officers of the Board shall be chosen 18 annually, to serve for a period of one year each; and shall be a 19 President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and an Executive Committee of not less than three nor more than seven 20 members, whose duty it shall be, under the direction and subject 21 to the approval of the Board of Trustees, to transact such 22 23 necessary business as may arise in the intervals between regular 24 meetings of the Board. No member of the Board shall receive 25 compensation for his services; but shall be paid necessary 26 traveling and hotel expenses actually incurred in the performance of duty as such member. The Treasurer shall not be a 27 28 member of the board, and shall give such bonds for the faithful 29 performance of his duties, and receive such compensation as the Board may, from time to time, direct.] (a) The officers of the 30
