## AN ACT

5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Short title.
7	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Enterprise
8	Case Management Act.
9	Section 2. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
11	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Department." The Department of Human Services of the
14	Commonwealth.
15	"Enterprise case management system." A method developed
16	through the department that:
17	(1) Provides enhanced case management for the

1 department, counties, service providers, participants and 2 individuals through the implementation of a common platform to assist in planning and delivering services regarding 3 multiple department-supervised programs. 4 5 (2) Includes the following subsystems: Home and community-based services. 6 (i) Hearings and appeals. 7 (ii) (iii) Office of Long-Term Living enrollment 8 9 services. 10 (iv) Child welfare case management services. Section 3. Child welfare case management subsystem. 11 12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or proposed 13 implementation timeline regarding the enterprise case management 14 system, the department shall complete the implementation of the 15 child welfare case management subsystem of the enterprise case management system by December 31, 2023 2026. 16 <---Section 4. Effective date. 17 18 This act shall take effect immediately.

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
