15	Section 1. The definition of "booth space" in section 1 of
16	the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the
17	Cosmetology Law, is amended to read:

4	Section 2. Section 8.1 of the act is repealed:
5	[Section 8.1. Booth Rental ProhibitedThe rental of booth
6	space by an owner of a cosmetology salon, or the owner of a
7	salon limited to esthetics, nail technology or natural hair
8	braiding, to any holder of a license issued under this act is
9	unlawful.]
10	Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
