## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, further providing for driving while operating 2 privilege is suspended or revoked. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1543(b)(1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 1543. Driving while operating privilege is suspended or 9 revoked. 10 (b) Certain offenses. --11 12 (i) A person who drives a motor vehicle on a 13 highway or trafficway of this Commonwealth at a time when 14 the person's operating privilege is suspended or revoked 15 as a condition of acceptance of Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition for a violation of section 16 17 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or

controlled substance) or the former section 3731, because

of a violation of section 1547(b)(1) (relating to suspension for refusal) or 3802 or former section 3731 or is suspended under section 1581 (relating to Driver's License Compact) for an offense substantially similar to a violation of section 3802 or former section 3731 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$500 and to undergo imprisonment for a period of not less than 60 days nor more than 90 days.

(ii) A second violation of this paragraph shall constitute a misdemeanor of the third degree. Upon conviction, the person committing the violation shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000 and to undergo imprisonment of not less than 90 days and not more than six months.

(iii) A third or subsequent violation of this

paragraph shall constitute a misdemeanor of the second

degree. Upon conviction, the person committing the

violation shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$2,500 and

to undergo imprisonment for not less than six months nor

more than two years.
