## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for 1 2 issuance and content of driver's license, providing for 3 contributions for autism spectrum disorder awareness and 5 establishing the Autism Spectrum Disorder Awareness Account. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 1510 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license. 10 \* \* \* 11 12 (a.2) Autism spectrum disorder designation. --13 (1) An individual who is diagnosed with an autism 14 spectrum disorder may request to have a notation of the 15 diagnosis placed on the individual's driver's license or 16 identification card. The individual must present the 17 department with a sworn statement from a qualified medical professional licensed in this Commonwealth verifying the 18 diagnosis. By submitting the request, the individual consents 19

- 1 for the department to make public the diagnosis on the
- 2 <u>individual's driver's license or identification card.</u>
- 3 (2) A parent or quardian of an individual under 18 years
- 4 <u>of age or under guardianship may request the notation</u>
- 5 provided under this subsection to be placed on the
- 6 <u>individual's driver's license or identification card. The</u>
- 7 parent or quardian must comply with all of the requirements
- 8 <u>under paragraph (1).</u>
- 9 <u>(3) The department shall promulgate regulations</u>
- 10 necessary to administer this subsection.

- 12 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 13 § 1521. Autism spectrum disorder awareness.
- 14 (a) Contributions. -- The department shall provide an
- 15 applicant for an original or renewal driver's license or
- 16 <u>identification card the opportunity to make a contribution of \$1</u>
- 17 to the Autism Spectrum Disorder Awareness Account established
- 18 under this section. The contribution shall be added to the
- 19 regular fee for an original or renewal driver's license or
- 20 <u>identification card. One contribution may be made for each</u>
- 21 issuance or renewal of a driver's license or identification
- 22 card. The department shall determine monthly the total amount
- 23 contributed under this section and shall report that amount to
- 24 the State Treasurer, who shall transfer that amount to the
- 25 Autism Spectrum Disorder Awareness Account.
- 26 (b) Account.--The Autism Spectrum Disorder Awareness Account
- 27 is established as a restricted account within the General Fund.
- 28 Money in the account shall be appropriated on a continuing basis
- 29 to the Department of Health for education and training of
- 30 working professionals on autism spectrum disorder.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
