AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in inchoate crimes, further providing for prohibited offensive weapons. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 908(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 3, 2022 (P.L.1782, No.119), is amended and subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 908. Prohibited offensive weapons. 10 * * * 11 12 (b) Exceptions. <--13 14 15 accelerated trigger activator purchased or otherwise obtained 16 by the defendant prior to the effective date of

- 2 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 3 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 4 subsection:
- 5 <u>"Accelerated trigger activator." A part or combination of</u>
- 6 parts designed and intended to accelerate the rate of fire of a
- 7 semiautomatic firearm to simulate the rate of fire of a
- 8 machinegun.
- 9 "Firearm." Any weapon which is designed to or may readily be
- 10 converted to expel any projectile by the action of an explosive
- 11 or the frame or receiver of any such weapon.
- 12 "Machinegun." As defined in 26 U.S.C. § 5845(b) (relating to
- 13 definitions).
- "Offensive weapons." Any bomb, grenade, [machine gun,]
- 15 <u>machinequn</u>, <u>accelerated trigger activator</u>, sawed-off shotgun
- 16 with a barrel less than 18 inches, firearm specially made or
- 17 specially adapted for concealment or silent discharge, any
- 18 blackjack, sandbag, metal knuckles, any stun gun, stun baton,
- 19 taser or other electronic or electric weapon or other implement
- 20 for the infliction of serious bodily injury which serves no
- 21 common lawful purpose.

- 23 Section 2. Within 10 days of the effective date of this
- 24 section, the Attorney General shall transmit notice describing
- 25 in detail the contents of this act to the Legislative Reference
- 26 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 28 (1) The following shall take effect immediately:
