## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 2014 (P.L.2911, No.191), entitled "An act providing for prescription drug monitoring; 2 creating the ABC-MAP Board; establishing the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program; and providing 4 for unlawful acts and penalties," further providing for 5 requirements for prescribers. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1.
