- Amending Titles 35 (Health and Safety) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in emergency medical
- services system, further providing for support of emergency
- medical services; in general provisions, further providing for EMS costs; and, in driving after imbibing alcohol or
- 6 utilizing drugs, further providing for Accelerated
- 7 Rehabilitative Disposition.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 10 Section 1. Section 8153(c) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
- 11 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 12 § 8153. Support of emergency medical services.

- 14 (c) Purpose of fund.--Except as provided under subsection
- 15 (d), 75% of the money from the Emergency Medical Services
- 16 Operating Fund shall be disbursed by the department [for only]
- 17 <u>in</u> the following [uses] <u>manner</u>:
- 18 (1) To [eligible] EMS agencies [for applicable purposes
- 19 stated under | in accordance with section 8112(c) (relating to

- 1 contracts and grants) [, with at least 10% of these funds to
- 2 be allocated to provide additional financial assistance for
- 3 those EMS systems serving rural areas.] 30% of funds must be
- 4 <u>allocated to specifically provide training to underserved</u>
- 5 rural areas. Not less than 10% of funds shall be provided to
- 6 EMS agencies to assist with medical equipment purchases for
- 7 ambulances.
- 8 (2) To the board for the performance of duties imposed
- 9 upon it under this chapter.
- 10 (3) To regional EMS councils for the development,
- 11 maintenance and improvement of EMS systems, including
- ambulance and communications equipment, and for training,
- education and EMS agency licensure purposes.
