AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for contributions for pediatric cancer research and establishing the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1321. Contributions for pediatric cancer research. (a) General rule. -- Within one year of the effective date of 10 this section, the department shall provide for all of the 11 12 following: 13 (1) Ability of an applicant for an original 14 driver's license or identification card A PERSON RENEWING A 15 DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD ELECTRONICALLY 16 THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE to make a contribution of \$5 to the Pediatric Cancer Research 17

8	(1) A contribution under subsection (a) shall be added,	-
9	as appropriate, to the regular fee for:	
10	(i) an original or A renewal driver's license or	<
11	identification card; and	
12	(ii) a renewal of a vehicle registration.	
13	(2) One contribution under subsection (a) may be made	
14	<pre>for:</pre>	
15	(i) each issuance or renewal of a driver's license	<
16	or identification card; and	
17	(ii) each renewal vehicle registration.	
18	(c) Use Contributions under subsection (a) shall be used	
19	exclusively for pediatric cancer research approved by the	
20	Pennsylvania Cancer Control, Prevention and Research Advisory	
21	Board established by the act December 18, 1980 (P.L.1241, No.	
22	224), known as the Pennsylvania Cancer Control, Prevention and	
23	Research Act.	
24	(d) Deposits	
25	(1) The department shall determine on a monthly basis	
26	the total amount collected under this section and report the	-
27	amount to the State Treasurer.	
28	(2) The State Treasurer shall transfer the amount	
29	collected to the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund, which fund	
30	is hereby established.	

- 1 (e) Reimbursement. -- The Pediatric Cancer Research Fund shall
- 2 reimburse the Motor License Fund for the actual costs incurred
- 3 by the department in the administration of this section.
- 4 <u>(f) Information.--</u>
- 5 (1) The department shall provide adequate information
- 6 <u>concerning the contribution for pediatric cancer research in</u>
- 7 <u>its instructions for the applicants described in subsection</u>
- 8 (a). The information concerning the contribution shall
- 9 include the listing of an address furnished by the Department
- of Health to which contributions may be sent by individuals
- 11 wishing to make additional contributions.
- 12 (2) The Department of Health shall conduct a public
- information campaign on the availability of this opportunity
- to Pennsylvania taxpayers.
- 15 (g) Reporting. -- The Department of Health shall report
- 16 annually to the respective committees of the Senate and the
- 17 House of Representatives that have jurisdiction over health
- 18 matters on the amount received from the contributions authorized
- 19 by this section and how the funds were used.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
