6	Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 705.1. Burial benefits.</u>
9	(a) Notice of deceased serviceperson to county
10	(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a LICENSED funeral <
11	director, funeral entity or cemetery company shall, within 96
12	hours OF RECEIPT OF THE REMAINS OF A DECEASED SERVICEPERSON, <
13	notify the county veterans affairs director of a deceased
14	serviceperson having legal residence in the county at the
15	time of death and provide the family of the deceased
16	serviceperson with the contact information for the county

1 <u>veterans affairs director.</u>

2	(2) Paragraph (1) shall apply to a cemetery company only
3	if the cemetery company is providing PROVIDES interment for <
4	the cremated remains of a deceased serviceperson for whom a
5	LICENSED funeral director or funeral entity did not provide <
6	goods or services.
7	(b) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
8	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
9	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
10	<u>"CEMETERY COMPANY." AS DEFINED IN 9 PA.C.S. § 101 (RELATING <</u>
11	TO DEFINITIONS).
12	"Deceased serviceperson." As defined in section 1908-A of
13	the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County
14	<u>Code.</u>
15	"Funeral entity." As defined in 49 Pa. Code § 13.1 (relating
16	to definitions).
17	"Licensed funeral director." As defined in 49 Pa. Code §
18	<u>13.1.</u>
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
