12	(1) A person who unintentionally causes the death of
13	another person as the result of a violation of section 3802
14	(relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled
15	substance) and who is convicted of violating section 3802:
16	(i) is guilty of a felony of the second degree; or
17	(ii) is guilty of a felony of the first degree if,
18	before sentencing on the present violation, the person
19	has incurred a conviction, adjudication of delinquency,
20	juvenile consent decree, acceptance of Accelerated

1 Rehabilitative Disposition or other form of preliminary disposition for any of the following: 2 An offense under section 3802. 3 (A) An offense under former section 3731 4 (B) 5 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance). 6 7 (C) An offense which constitutes a felony under 8 this subchapter. 9 An offense substantially similar to an (D) 10 offense under clause (A), (B) or (C) in another jurisdiction. 11 12 (E) Any combination of the offenses under clause 13 (A), (B), (C) or (D). 14 (iii) is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second 15 degree when the violation is not the cause of death, and the sentencing court shall impose a fine of not more than 16 17 \$5,000. * * * 18 19 § 3735.1. Aggravated assault by vehicle while driving under the 20 influence. 21 Offense defined. -- Any person who negligently causes (a) serious bodily injury to another person as the result of a 22 23 violation of section 3802 (relating to driving under influence 24 of alcohol or controlled substance) and who is convicted of 25 violating section 3802 commits [a]: 26 (1) A felony of the second degree when the violation is 27 the cause of the injury. (2) A misdemeanor of the second degree when the 28 29 violation is not the cause of the injury and the sentencing 30 court shall impose a fine of not more than \$2,500.
