## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act concerning townships of the 2 second class; and amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the law relating thereto," in election of officers 4 and vacancies in office, further providing for vacancies in 5 general. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 407 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, is amended to 10 11 read: 12 Section 407. Vacancies in General. -- (a) If the electors of 13 any township fail to choose a supervisor, tax collector or 14 auditor, or if any person elected to any office fails to serve 15 in the office, or if a vacancy occurs in the office by death, 16 resignation <u>under subsection (b)</u>, removal from the township or 17 otherwise, the board of supervisors may appoint a successor who 18 is [an] a registered elector of the township and has resided in that township continuously for at least one year prior to their 19

appointment\_[, and, upon their failure to make the appointment

- 1 within thirty days after the vacancy occurs, the vacancy shall
- 2 be filled within fifteen additional days by the vacancy board.
- 3 The vacancy board shall consist of the board of supervisors and
- 4 one elector of the township, who shall be appointed by the board
- 5 of supervisors at the board's first meeting each calendar year
- 6 or as soon after that as practical and who shall act as chairman
- 7 of the vacancy board. If the vacancy board fails to fill the
- 8 position within fifteen days, the chairman shall, or if there is
- 9 a vacancy in the chairmanship the remaining members of the
- 10 vacancy board shall, petition the court of common pleas to fill
- 11 the vacancy. If two or more vacancies in the office of
- 12 supervisor occur on a three-member board or three or more
- 13 vacancies on a five-member board, the court of common pleas
- 14 shall fill the vacancies upon presentation of petition signed by
- 15 not less than fifteen electors of the township. The successor so
- 16 appointed shall hold the office until the first Monday in
- 17 January after the first municipal election which occurs more
- 18 than sixty days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an
- 19 eligible person shall be elected for the unexpired term.]
- 20 (b) A resignation:
- 21 (1) Shall not create a vacancy until the date that the
- 22 <u>resignation is accepted by a majority vote of the board of</u>
- 23 supervisors at a public meeting or the effective date of the
- 24 <u>tendered resignation</u>, whichever is later. The board of
- 25 supervisors must accept a tendered resignation no later than
- 26 forty-five days after the resignation has been tendered to the
- 27 board of supervisors, unless the resignation is withdrawn in
- 28 writing prior to acceptance.
- 29 (2) That is not accepted as under paragraph (1) shall be
- 30 deemed accepted forty-five days after the resignation has been

- 1 tendered to the board of supervisors.
- 2 (c) If, for any reason, the board of supervisors refuses,
- 3 <u>fails, neglects or is unable to fill a vacancy within thirty</u>
- 4 days after the vacancy occurs, as under this section, the
- 5 vacancy shall be filled within fifteen additional days by the
- 6 vacancy board. The vacancy board shall consist of the board of
- 7 <u>supervisors and one registered elector of the township, who</u>
- 8 shall be appointed by the board of supervisors at the board's
- 9 <u>first meeting each calendar year or as soon thereafter as is</u>
- 10 practical. The appointed elector shall act as the chairperson of
- 11 the vacancy board.
- 12 (d) If the vacancy board fails to fill the position within
- 13 <u>fifteen days</u>, the chairperson, or if the position of the
- 14 <u>chairperson is vacant, the remaining members of the vacancy</u>
- 15 board shall petition the court of common pleas to fill the
- 16 <u>vacancy</u>.
- 17 (e) If two or more vacancies in the office of supervisor
- 18 occur on a three-member board, or three or more vacancies occur
- 19 on a five-member board, the court of common pleas shall fill the
- 20 vacancies upon presentation of a petition signed by at least
- 21 fifteen registered electors of the township.
- 22 (f) A successor appointed under this section shall hold
- 23 <u>office until the first Monday in January after the first</u>
- 24 municipal election which occurs at least sixty days after the
- 25 <u>vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be</u>
- 26 elected for the unexpired term.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
