- 6 Section 1. Section 2709.1(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2709.1. Stalking.
- 9 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits the crime of stalking
- 10 when the person either:
- 11 (1) engages in a course of conduct or repeatedly commits
- 12 acts toward another person, including following the person
- without proper authority, whether the other person has
- 14 <u>knowledge or not</u>, under circumstances which demonstrate
- 15 either an intent to place such other person in reasonable
- 16 fear of bodily injury or to cause substantial emotional
- distress to such other person; or
- 18 (2) engages in a course of conduct or repeatedly

- 1 communicates to another person, whether the other person has
- 2 <u>knowledge or not</u>, under circumstances which demonstrate or
- 3 communicate either an intent to place such other person in
- 4 reasonable fear of bodily injury or to cause substantial
- 5 emotional distress to such other person.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
