AN ACT

- 1 Designating a portion of State Route 61 in Schuylkill County,
- from State Route 443 to State Route 2014, as the Captain
- Jason B. Jones Memorial Highway.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Captain Jason B. Jones Memorial Highway.
- 7 (a) Findings.--
- 8 (1) Captain Jason B. Jones, a native of Orwigsburg,
- 9 graduated with honors from Blue Mountain High School in 2003,
- 10 having earned eight varsity letters.
- 11 (2) In 2007, Captain Jones graduated sixth in his class
- from West Point Military Academy with a degree in nuclear
- 13 engineering.
- 14 (3) Captain Jones was awarded the Bronze Star for his

- 1 performance during deployment to Iraq in 2008 to 2009.
- 2 (4) In May 2013, Captain Jones completed the Special
- Forces Qualification Course to join the ranks of the Army
- 4 Special Forces, known as the Green Berets, and was deployed
- 5 to Afghanistan in April 2014.
- 6 (5) While serving as commander of a 12-man Special
- 7 Forces A-Team in Jalalabad, Afghanistan, Captain Jones, age
- 8 29, made the ultimate sacrifice for his country when he was
- 9 killed by small arms fire.
- 10 (b) Designation. -- The section of State Route 61 in
- 11 Schuylkill County, from State Route 443 to State Route 2014, is
- 12 hereby designated the Captain Jason B. Jones Memorial Highway.
- 13 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 14 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to

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- 15 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 16 Section 2. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect immediately IN 60 DAYS.
