## AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in child custody, further providing 2 3 for award of custody. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5323(g)(1) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 5323. Award of custody. \* \* \* 9 10 (g) Contempt for noncompliance with any custody order. --11 A party who willfully fails to comply with any 12 custody order may, as prescribed by general rule, be adjudged 13 in contempt. Contempt shall be punishable by any one or more 14 of the following: 15 Imprisonment for a period of not more than six (i)16 months. 17 (ii) A fine of not more than \$500.
