AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for
3 persons ineligible for licensing, license issuance to minors
4 and junior driver's license and for learners' permits.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 1503(c) introductory paragraph and
8 1505(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
9 amended to read:

10 § 1503. Persons ineligible for licensing; license issuance to
11 minors; junior driver's license.

12 * * *

13 (c) Junior driver's license.--The department may issue a
14 junior driver's license to a person 15, 16 or 17 years of age
15 under rules and regulations adopted by the department and
16 subject to the provisions of this section. A junior driver's
17 license shall automatically become a regular driver's license
18 when the junior driver attains 18 years of age.

1 § 1505. Learners' permits.

2 (a) General rule.--A person 15 years or older who desires to
3 obtain a driver's license or who desires to be licensed in a
4 class for which the person is not already licensed shall apply
5 to the department for the class or classes of license in which
6 the person desires to be licensed. The department shall issue to
7 each applicant a learner's permit which shall clearly identify
8 the class of license applied for as provided in section 1504
9 (relating to classes of licenses).

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
