1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for surrender of registration plates and cards upon suspension or revocation and providing for suspension of registration for failure to respond to citation; and, in fees, further providing for reinstatement of operating privilege or vehicle registration.

10	Section 1. Section 1376(b.1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
11	Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
12	§ 1376. Surrender of registration plates and cards upon
13	suspension or revocation.

15	(b.1) Immediate seizure of registration plates and cards
16	The department may delegate authority to the persons described
17	in this section to immediately seize registration plates and
18	cards upon imposition of the following:
19	(1) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1374(d)(3)
20	or (4) (relating to suspension or revocation of vehicle
21	business registration plates) until all fees, taxes and

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penalties have been paid;

2 (2) a suspension or revocation imposed pursuant to 3 section 1373(b)(3) (relating to suspension of registration) 4 or 1374(g);

5 (3) a suspension or revocation is reinstated after 6 determination of a matter as provided in section 1377 7 (relating to judicial review);

8 (4) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1379 9 (relating to suspension of registration upon sixth unpaid 10 parking violation in cities of the first class) until all 11 fines, penalties and costs have been paid; [or]

(5) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1380
(relating to suspension of registration upon unpaid tolls)
until all tolls, administrative fees and costs have been
paid, dismissed, reversed on appeal or canceled or if the
owner or registrant enters into an agreement with the tolling
entity to make installment payments[.]; or

 19 (relating to suspension of registration for failure to
 20 respond to citation).

22 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
23 <u>§ 1381. Suspension of registration for failure to respond to</u>

(a) Suspension of registration.--The department shall
suspend the registration of a vehicle upon the notification from
an issuing authority or a court that the owner or registrant of
the vehicle has failed to respond to a citation or summons to
appear before an issuing authority or a court of competent
jurisdiction of this Commonwealth for any violation of this

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1	title, other than parking, or who has failed to pay or defaulted
2	in the payment of any fine, costs or restitution imposed by an
3	issuing authority or the courts for violation of this title.
4	(b) NoticeAt least 15 days before an issuing authority or
5	a court notifies the department to impose a suspension under
6	subsection (a), the issuing authority or court shall provide the
7	owner or registrant written notice of the requirement to respond
8	to the citation and pay all fines, restitution and penalties
9	imposed by the issuing authority or court.
10	(c) Period of suspensionA suspension under subsection (a)
11	shall continue until the department receives notice from the
12	issuing authority or court that the owner or registrant
13	responded to the citation and paid all fines, restitution and
14	penalties imposed or entered into an agreement with the issuing
15	authority or court to make installment payments for the fines,
16	restitution and penalties imposed. The suspension may be
17	reimposed by the department if the defendant fails to make
18	regular installment payments and, if applicable, fails to pay
19	the fee prescribed in section 1960 (relating to reinstatement of
20	operating privilege or vehicle registration).
21	(d) Violations outside Commonwealth
22	(1) The department shall suspend the registration of a
23	vehicle of any owner or registrant who has failed to respond
24	to a citation to appear before a court of competent
25	jurisdiction of the United States or any state that has
26	entered into an enforcement agreement with the department, as
27	authorized under section 6146 (relating to enforcement
28	agreements), for any violation of the motor vehicle laws of
29	such state, other than parking, or who has failed to pay any
30	fine or costs imposed by such court upon being duly notified

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1 <u>in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction in which the</u>

2 <u>violation occurred.</u>

3 (2) An owner or registrant who provides proof

4 <u>satisfactory to the department that the full amount of the</u>

5 <u>fine and costs has been forwarded to and received by the</u>

6 <u>other state may not be regarded as having failed to pay for</u>

7 <u>the purposes of this subsection.</u>

8 (e) Admissibility of documents.--A copy of a document issued

9 by an issuing authority or a court of this Commonwealth or by an

10 <u>official of another state shall be admissible for the purpose of</u> 11 proving a violation of this section.

Section 3. Section 1960 of Title 75 is amended to read: 13 § 1960. Reinstatement of operating privilege or vehicle 14 registration.

15 The department shall charge a fee of \$70 or, if section 1379 (relating to suspension of registration upon sixth unpaid 16 17 parking violation in cities of the first class), 1380 (relating 18 to suspension of registration upon unpaid tolls), 1381 (relating 19 to suspension of registration for failure to respond to 20 <u>citation</u>) or 1786(d) (relating to required financial responsibility) applies, a fee of \$88 to restore a person's 21 22 operating privilege or the registration of a vehicle following a 23 suspension or revocation.

24 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 180 days.

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
