## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in support matters, further providing for cooperation of government and nongovernment agencies.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 4304.1(a)(2) of Title 23 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 4304.1. Cooperation of government and nongovernment agencies.
9	(a) Cooperation of government agenciesNotwithstanding any
10	other provision of law, including the provisions of section 731
11	of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The
12	Fiscal Code, all government agencies shall:
13	* * *
14	(2) Require the Social Security number of an individual
15	who has one on any application for a professional or
16	occupational license or certification; a permit; a driver's

license, including a commercial driver's license; [a 1 2 recreational license;] or a marriage license. Collection of 3 the Social Security number shall be performed in such manner 4 as to protect its confidentiality. If the government agency uses another identifying number on the face of the 5 application, the government agency shall advise the applicant 6 7 and shall keep the Social Security number on file at the 8 agency.

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10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
