- 11 (e) Residency. -- A sexually violent predator may not reside
- 12 within 2,500 feet of a public school, private school, parochial
- 13 <u>school or day-care center for the duration of the required</u>
- 14 period of registration under subsection (b). The following
- 15 apply:
- (1) A sexually violent predator who resides within 2,500
- 17 <u>feet of a public school, private school, parochial school or</u>
- 18 day-care center on the effective date of this paragraph
- 19 shall, within six months after the effective date of this
- 20 paragraph or upon the expiration of the lease, rental
- 21 <u>agreement or similar contractual obligation regarding the</u>
- 22 residence, whichever is later, relocate to another residence
- 23 that is situated at least 2,500 feet from a public school,
- 24 private school, parochial school or day-care center.
- 25 (2) If, on or after the effective date of this

- 7 (3) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
- 8 <u>override or abrogate any law enforcement notification</u>
- 9 <u>requirements under this chapter.</u>
- 10 (f) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 11 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 12 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Day-care center." Premises operated for profit in which
- 14 <u>child care is provided simultaneously for five or more children</u>
- 15 who are not relatives of the operator of the premises.
- 16 "Public school." As defined in 24 Pa.C.S. § 8102 (relating
- 17 to definitions).
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
