AN ACT

1 2	Designating a portion of State Route 22/322 in Juniata County as the Honorable Daniel F. Clark Memorial Highway.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. The Honorable Daniel F. Clark Memorial Highway.
6	(a) FindingsThe General Assembly finds and declares as
7	follows:
8	(1) Daniel F. Clark was a Republican member of the
9	Pennsylvania House of Representatives, representing the 82nd
10	Legislative District from 1989 until 2002. The 82nd District
11	includes all of Juniata County and portions of Mifflin and
12	Franklin Counties.

1 (2) A native of Mifflintown, Dan was a 1972 graduate of 2 East Juniata High School, 1976 graduate of Lycoming College, 3 and 1979 graduate of Duquesne University School of Law.

Dan was well known for his dedication as a public 4 (3) 5 servant. He served as the Juniata County District Attorney 6 from 1984 to 1988 and was first elected to the Pennsylvania 7 House of Representatives in 1988.

8 (4) Representative Clark served as the Chairman of the 9 House Judiciary Subcommittee on Courts where he was appointed 10 as one of the lead prosecutors in the case to impeach Supreme Court Justice Rolf Larsen. His involvement was described as a 11 12 "footnote to history".

13 (5) Representative Clark was also a tireless advocate 14 for expanding the Route 322 corridor during his time in the 15 legislature. He recognized the need for infrastructure 16 investment in the region and put in the hard work to make 17 sure it happened. To Dan's credit, his vision for a 18 modernized transportation corridor in central Pennsylvania 19 came to fruition and brought with it a better quality of life 20 for many central Pennsylvanians and more opportunities for 21 economic development and prosperity in the region.

22 Dan would return again to the House of (6) 23 Representatives in December of 2010 to serve as Chief Counsel 24 to the House Republican Appropriations Committee.

Dan Clark was well respected in his community and (7)26 enjoyed traveling, playing golf, Penn State football and 27 spending time with his family.

Sadly, on September 28, 2014, Dan Clark passed away 28 (8) 29 at home surrounded by his family.

Clark Memorial Highway. 10 (c) Signs.---The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the 11 highway to traffic in both directions on the highway. 12 Section 2. Effective date. 13 14 This act shall take effect immediately IN 60 DAYS.
