## AN ACT

- Providing for outpatient psychiatric oversight. 1
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 3
- Section 1. Short title. 4
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Outpatient
- Psychiatric Oversight Act. 6
- Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 "Advanced practice professional." A registered, licensed or <--
- 12 certified health care practitioner who has gained additional
- 13 specialized knowledge, skills and experience through a program-
- of study in that specialty. A PERSON WHO: 14
- 15 HOLDS A CURRENT PENNSYLVANIA LICENSE AS A (1)(I)
- CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE PRACTITIONER WITH A MENTAL 16

- 1 HEALTH CERTIFICATION; OR
- 2 (II) OBTAINS A MENTAL HEALTH CERTIFICATION WITHIN
- 3 TWO YEARS OF BEING HIRED BY A PSYCHIATRIC OUTPATIENT
- 4 CLINIC OR WITHIN TWO YEARS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 5 SECTION, WHICHEVER IS LATER; OR
- 6 (2) (I) HOLDS A CURRENT PENNSYLVANIA LICENSE AS A
- 7 PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT WITH A MENTAL HEALTH CERTIFICATION;
- 8 OR
- 9 (II) OBTAINS A MENTAL HEALTH CERTIFICATION WITHIN
- 10 TWO YEARS OF BEING HIRED BY A PSYCHIATRIC OUTPATIENT
- 11 CLINIC OR WITHIN TWO YEARS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 12 SECTION, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
- "Department." The Department of Human Services of the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 "Full-time equivalent." Thirty-seven and one-half hours per

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- 16 week.
- 17 "INTERACTIVE AUDIO AND VIDEO." REAL-TIME TWO-WAY OR
- 18 MULTIPLE-WAY COMMUNICATION BETWEEN A PSYCHIATRIST AND AN
- 19 INDIVIDUAL.
- 20 "Outpatient psychiatric clinic." A nonresidential treatment
- 21 setting in which psychiatric, psychological, social, educational
- 22 and other related services are provided under medical
- 23 supervision. It is designed for the evaluation and treatment of
- 24 individuals of any age with mental illness or emotional
- 25 distress. Outpatient services are provided on a planned and
- 26 regularly scheduled basis.
- 27 "Psychiatrist." A physician who has completed at least three
- 28 years of a residency in psychiatry and is licensed to practice
- 29 psychiatry in this Commonwealth.
- 30 "Telepsychiatry." The practice of medicine in the specialty <--

- 1 field of psychiatry using electronic communications, information
- 2 technology or other means between a provider in one location and
- 3 a patient in another location, with or without an intervening
- 4 health care provider. The term does not include any of the
- 5 <del>following:</del>
- 6 (1) An audio-only, telephone conversation.
- 7 (2) An e-mail or instant messaging conversation.
- 8 (3) A facsimile transmission.
- 9 Section 3. Requirements.
- 10 The following shall apply:
- 11 Except as provided for in paragraph (2), an 12 outpatient psychiatric clinic is required to SHALL have a <--13 psychiatrist on site for two hours of psychiatric time per 14 week for each full-time equivalent treatment staff member 15 employed by the outpatient psychiatric clinic. Telepsychiatry <--16 provided by a psychiatrist that is not on site withprescriptive authority in this Commonwealth may be utilized 17 18 with a service description approved by the department but-19 shall not be included in the required psychiatric time-20 required under this paragraph.
  - (2) Fifty percent of the required on-site psychiatric time under paragraph (1) may be provided by other advanced <-practice professionals specializing in behavioral health with prescriptive authority in this Commonwealth::
- 25 (I) AN ADVANCED PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL.
- 26 (II) A PSYCHIATRIST OFF-SITE BY THE USE OF TWO WAY <-27 REAL TIME INTERACTIVE AUDIO AND VIDEO TRANSMISSION USING <-28 TECHNOLOGY THAT CONFORMS TO INDUSTRYWIDE COMPRESSED
  29 AUDIO-VIDEO COMMUNICATION AND PROTECTS CONFIDENTIALITY
  30 UNDER FEDERAL AND STATE LAW IN ACCORDANCE WITH

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- 1 DEPARTMENT-ISSUED GUIDELINES. TELEPHONE CONVERSATION <--
- 2 INTERACTIVE AUDIO WITHOUT VIDEO, ELECTRONIC MAIL MESSAGE <--
- 3 OR FACSIMILE TRANSMISSION MAY NOT BE USED TO MEET THE
- 4 REQUIREMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1).
- 5 (III) A COMBINATION OF SUBPARAGRAPHS (I) AND (II).
- 6 Section 4. Regulations.
- 7 The department shall promulgate regulations as necessary to
- 8 carry out the provisions of this act.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
