## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of certain public officials including justices and judges of Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor General, the Attorney General and certain other State officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent acts," further providing for compensation of members of the General Assembly.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 4(d) and (d.1) of the act of September
16	30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official
17	Compensation Law, are amended and the section is amended by
18	adding a subsection to read:
19	Section 4. Members of the General Assembly.

21	(d) Subsequent annual cost-of-living adjustment for
22	members[For] Except as provided under subsection (e), for the

12-month period beginning December 1, 1997, through November 30, 1 2 1998, and for each like 12-month period thereafter, the salary 3 of the members of the General Assembly shall be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated by applying the 4 percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban 5 Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and 6 Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month period for which 7 8 figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately 9 10 prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to the 11 then current salary amounts. The percentage increase and the new 12 salary amounts shall be determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of 13 the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives 14 prior to the annual effective date of the adjustment and shall 15 be published by them in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within ten 16 days of the date such determination is made.

17 (d.1) Subsequent annual cost-of-living adjustment for 18 officers and leaders. -- [For] Except as provided under subsection\_ 19 (e), for the 12-month period beginning December 1, 1997, through 20 November 30, 1998, and for each like 12-month period thereafter, the additional compensation of the officers and leaders of the 21 22 General Assembly shall be increased by an annual cost-of-living 23 adjustment calculated by applying the percentage change in the 24 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the 25 Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the 26 most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, 27 28 Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to the date the 29 adjustment is due to take effect, to the then current 30 compensation. The percentage increase and the new compensation

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amounts shall be determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the 1 Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives prior 2 to the annual effective date of the adjustment and shall be 3 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within 20 days 4 immediately prior to each cost-of-living increase taking effect. 5 6 (e) Moratorium on annual cost-of-living adjustment.--The\_ compensation of members, officers and leaders of the General 7 Assembly may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living 8 9 adjustment under subsections (d) and (d.1) for the period beginning December 1, 2017, through November 30, 2020. Notice of 10 the provisions of this subsection shall be published in the 11 Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1, 2017. 12

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
