8	Section 1. Sections 13A63(b)(4) and 1403(c)(2)(iv) of Title

12	(b) Distributions to countiesThe department shall make

19	(4) The following apply:

1 If the facility is a Category 3 licensed (i) 2 facility located in a county of the second class A: 50% 3 of the licensed facility's local share assessment shall be [deposited into a restricted receipts account to be 4 established in the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be 5 6 used exclusively for grants or guarantees for projects in 7 the county that qualify under 64 Pa.C.S. §§ 1551 8 (relating to Business in Our Sites Program), 1556 9 (relating to Tax Increment Financing Guarantee Program) 10 and 1558 (relating to Water Supply and Waste Water 11 Infrastructure Program).] distributed as follows: 12 (A) Seventy-five percent shall be deposited to 13 the county hosting the licensed facility from each 14 licensed facility for the purpose of supporting the maintenance and refurbishment of the parks and 15 16 heritage sites throughout the county in which the licensee is located. 17 18 (B) Twelve and one-half percent shall be 19 deposited to the county hosting the licensed facility 20 from each licensed facility for the purpose of 21 supporting a child advocacy center located within the 22 county in which the licensee is located. 23 (C) Twelve and one-half percent shall be 24 deposited to the county hosting the licensed facility 25 from each licensed facility for the purpose of 26 supporting an organization providing comprehensive support services to victims of domestic violence, 27 28 including legal and medical aid, shelters, 29 transitional housing and counseling located within 30 the county in which the licensee is located.

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1 (ii) Except as provided in subparagraph (i), if the 2 facility is a Category 3 licensed facility in a county of 3 any class: 50% of the licensed facility's local share assessment shall be added to the funds in the restricted 4 receipts account established under section 1403(c)(2)(iv) 5 for distribution with those funds. 6 * * * 7 8 § 1403. Establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine 9 revenue distribution. * * * 10 11 (c) Transfers and distributions. -- The department shall: * * * 12 13 (2) From the local share assessment established in 14 subsection (b), make quarterly distributions among the 15 counties hosting a licensed facility in accordance with the 16 following schedule: * * * 17 18 (iv) (A) Except as provided in clause (B) or (C), 19 if the facility is a Category 3 licensed facility, 2% 20 of the gross terminal revenue from the licensed 21 facility shall be deposited into a restricted 22 receipts account established in the Department of 23 Community and Economic Development to be used 24 exclusively for grants to the county, to economic 25 development authorities or redevelopment authorities 26 within the county for grants for economic development projects, community improvement projects and other 27 28 projects in the public interest. 29 If the facility is a Category 3 licensed (B)

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facility located in a county of the second class A,

1 2% of the gross terminal revenue [from the licensed 2 facility shall be deposited into a restricted 3 receipts account to be established in the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used 4 exclusively for grants or guarantees for projects in 5 the host county that qualify under 64 Pa.C.S. §§ 1551 6 7 (relating to Business in Our Sites Program), 1556 8 (relating to Tax Increment Financing Guarantee 9 Program) and 1558 (relating to Water Supply and 10 Wastewater Infrastructure Program).] to the county_ 11 hosting the licensed facility from each licensed 12 facility shall be deposited as follows: (I) Seventy-five percent shall be deposited 13 14 for the purpose of supporting the maintenance and 15 refurbishment of the parks and heritage sites 16 throughout the county in which the licensee is 17 located. 18 (II) Twelve and one-half percent shall be 19 deposited for the purpose of supporting a child 20 advocacy center located within the county in 21 which the licensee is located. 22 (III) Twelve and one-half percent shall be 23 deposited for the purpose of supporting an 24 organization providing comprehensive support 25 services to victims of domestic violence, 26 including legal and medical aid, shelters, 27 transitional housing and counseling located 28 within the county in which the licensee is 29 located. 30 (C) If the facility is a Category 3 licensed

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1 facility located in a county of the fifth class that is contiguous to a county of the seventh class, 2% of 2 the gross terminal revenue from the licensed facility 3 shall be deposited into a restricted receipts account 4 5 to be established in the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used exclusively for grants within 6 7 the county for economic development projects, infrastructure projects, community improvement 8 9 projects and other projects in the public interest 10 within the county and for infrastructure projects within a 20-mile radius of the licensed facility in a 11 contiguous county of the seventh class. 12 * * * 13

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
