L5	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
L6	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
L7	context clearly indicates otherwise:

1	"Commonwealth program." A program administered by the
2	Commonwealth that requires, as a condition for eligibility, the
3	inclusion of an individual's income.
4	"Veteran." An individual who served in the United States
5	Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard,
6	and who was discharged from that service under conditions other
7	than dishonorable.
8	"Veterans' benefit payment." Compensation or payment
9	received by a veteran that is directly related to or the result
10	of the veteran's service-connected disability as determined by
11	the United States Veterans Administration.
12	§ 9902. Exclusion.
13	(a) General ruleOne hundred percent of a veterans'
14	benefit payment may not be included as income for any
15	Commonwealth program.
16	(b) Extension to spousesThe exclusion under this section
17	shall apply to an unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of a
18	veteran for any compensation or payment the unmarried surviving
19	spouse is entitled to receive.
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
