4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Part III of Title 67 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

9	AUTISM SCREENING

11	<u>4101. Definitions.</u>
12	<u>4102. Autism screening.</u>
13	<u>§ 4101. Definitions.</u>
14	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
15	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16	context clearly indicates otherwise:
17	"Licensed child care provider." A premises licensed under 55
18	Pa. Code Ch. 20 (relating to licensure or approval of facilities

1	and agencies) and operating under the requirements of 55 Pa.
2	Code Ch. 3270 (relating to child care centers) that provides
3	care at any one time for seven or more minors unrelated to the
4	<u>operator.</u>
5	<u>§ 4102. Autism screening.</u>
6	The department shall:
7	(1) Develop an autism screening tool that may be used by
8	a licensed child care provider in this Commonwealth to screen
9	children who are 18 months of age, 24 months of age and 36
10	months of age in the licensed child care provider's care for
11	<u>autism.</u>
12	(2) Develop and distribute instructions regarding the
13	use of the autism screening tool, including all of the
14	following information:
15	(i) A notice that the autism screening tool should
16	not be construed as a medical diagnosis.
17	(ii) A list of resources pertaining to the diagnosis
18	of autism and applicable services within this
19	Commonwealth.
20	(3) Provide a licensed child care provider with the
21	information under paragraph (2) on an annual basis.
22	(4) Notify a licensed child care provider that the
23	licensed child care provider may review and assist an
24	individual with the use of the autism screening tool if the
25	individual requests assistance, but are not required to
26	provide the assistance.
27	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
