1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law enforcement officers or National Guard members who die as a result of the performance of their duties," providing for the payment of death benefits to members of the Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. Section 1(a), (a.1), (c) and (e) of the act of
12	June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency
13	and Law Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended
14	October 9, 2009 (P.L.588, No.51), are amended to read:
15	Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer,
16	ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified
17	hazardous material response team member <u>, member of the</u>
18	<u>Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol</u> or National Guard member dies as a
19	result of the performance of his duties, such political

1 subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of National 2 Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of a member 3 of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the authorized 4 survivor or the agency head, within [90 days] <u>THREE YEARS</u> from <---5 the date of death, shall submit certification of such death to 6 the Commonwealth.

7 (a.1) A firefighter, ambulance service or rescue squad 8 member, law enforcement officer, certified hazardous material response team member, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air 9 <u>Patrol</u> or National Guard member who suffers a fatal heart attack 10 11 or stroke while on duty or not later than 24 hours after participating in a physical training exercise or responding to 12 13 an emergency is presumed to have died as a result of the 14 performance of his duties for purposes of this act.

16 (c) A volunteer ambulance service, certified hazardous material response team, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air_ 17 18 <u>Patrol</u> or rescue squad member shall be deemed to be acting in 19 the performance of his duties for the purposes of this act going 20 to or directly returning from an emergency which the ambulance service, certified hazardous material response team, member of 21 the Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol or rescue squad attended 22 23 including travel from and direct return to an ambulance service, 24 certified hazardous material response team, member of the 25 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol or rescue squad member's home, place of business or other place where he or she shall have been 26 27 when he or she received the call or alarm or while participating 28 in drills in which the ambulance service, certified hazardous 29 material response team, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air 30 Patrol or rescue squad shall have participated or while

repairing or doing other work about or on any emergency vehicle 1 2 or buildings and grounds of the ambulance service, certified 3 hazardous material response team, member of the Pennsylvania <u>Civil Air Patrol</u> or rescue squad upon the authorization of the 4 5 chief of the ambulance service, certified hazardous material response team, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol or 6 7 rescue squad or other person in charge while answering any 8 emergency calls for any purpose or while riding upon any vehicles which are owned or used by the ambulance service, 9 10 certified hazardous material response team, member of the 11 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol or rescue squad.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall pay out of the 13 (e) 14 General Fund to the surviving spouse or, if there is no 15 surviving spouse, the minor children of a National Guard member, 16 certified hazardous material response team member, member of the Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol, volunteer firefighter, ambulance 17 18 service or rescue squad member who died as a result of the 19 performance of his duties the sum of \$100,000, adjusted in 20 accordance with subsection (f) of this section. When no spouse 21 or minor children survive, the benefit shall be paid to the parent or parents of such National Guard member, certified 22 23 hazardous material response team member, member of the 24 Pennsylvania Civil Air Patrol, volunteer firefighter, ambulance 25 service or rescue squad member. The benefit shall be payable 26 whether or not the National Guard member or certified hazardous material response team member, member of the Pennsylvania Civil_ 27 28 Air Patrol, volunteer firefighter, ambulance service or rescue 29 squad member died as a result of the performance of his duty 30 within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
