AN ACT

- 1 Providing for fair assistance insurance responsibility, for
- investigations occurring from a disaster and for
- 3 applicability.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Fair
- 8 Assistance Insurance Responsibility (FAIR) Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.
- "Disaster." Any of the following:
- 15 (1) A natural catastrophe, regardless of cause, a fire,
- 16 flood or explosion, in any part of the United States that, in
- the determination of the President of the United States,
- 18 causes damage of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant

- 1 assistance under 42 U.S.C. Ch. 68 (relating to disaster
- 2 relief) to supplement the efforts and available resources of
- 3 States, local governments and disaster relief organizations
- 4 in alleviating the damage, loss, hardship or suffering.
- 5 (2) A hurricane, tornado, storm, flood, high water,
- 6 wind-driven water, tidal wave, earthquake, landslide,
- 7 mudslide, snowstorm, drought, fire, explosion or other
- 8 catastrophe resulting in substantial property damage,
- 9 hardship, suffering or possible loss of life and results in
- 10 the Governor requesting that the President of the United
- 11 States declare a major disaster declaration or emergency
- declaration as warranted under 42 U.S.C. Ch. 68.
- "Insurer." An entity licensed or authorized to conduct the
- 14 business of insurance that is governed under the act of May 17,
- 15 1921 (P.L.628, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of
- 16 1921.
- "Investigation." As defined under 31 Pa. Code § 146.2
- 18 (relating to definitions).
- 19 Section 3. Investigations occurring from a disaster.
- 20 The following apply:
- 21 (1) When a policyholder files a homeowners' insurance
- 22 claim for damages arising from a disaster, the policyholder
- 23 must inform the insurer of the contact information for either
- the policyholder or the policyholder's designated point of
- 25 contact.
- 26 (2) Upon receipt of the claim, an insurer shall notify a
- 27 policyholder of:
- 28 (i) The consumer complaint process for
- 29 unsatisfactory service and regulatory violations provided
- 30 by the department.

- 1 (ii) Information concerning how to access the
- 2 complaint process.
- 3 (3) The notification under paragraph (2) must occur
- 4 within 10 business days.
- 5 (4) An extension afforded to an insurer for a claim
- 6 investigation is null and void when responding to a
- 7 homeowners' insurance claim for damages arising from a
- 8 disaster.
- 9 Section 4. Applicability.
- 10 This act applies to the claims filed on or after the
- 11 effective date of this section.
- 12 Section 5. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
