Cruelty to animal. \* \* \* 10 11 (b) Grading. --12 Except as set forth in [paragraph (2)] paragraphs 1.3 (2) and (3), a violation of this section is a summary 14 offense. 15 If the violation causes bodily injury to the animal 16 or places the animal at imminent risk of serious bodily

injury, a violation of this section is a misdemeanor of the
