20	apply to particularly vulnerable children. If a parent or family

2	been abducted by a nonparent or nonfamily member, there shall be
3	a presumption, absent immediately available clear evidence to
4	the contrary, that the child is in imminent danger of serious
5	bodily injury or death and the Missing Endangered Person
6	Advisory System shall be immediately activated without
7	additional investigation prior to activation of the Pennsylvania
8	Amber Alert System. This provision shall be known as the "Nalani
9	Johnson Rule" to protect this Commonwealth's particularly
10	vulnerable children from harm.
