## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 75 (Vehicles) of
- the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in other offenses,
- repealing provisions relating to violation of governmental
- 4 rules regarding traffic; and, in rules of the road in
- general, further providing for prohibitions in specified
- 6 places.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 7505 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 10 Consolidated Statutes is repealed:
- 11 [§ 7505. Violation of governmental rules regarding traffic.
- 12 Each Commonwealth agency shall promulgate rules and
- 13 regulations governing all vehicular traffic at those
- 14 Commonwealth facilities situated upon property of the
- 15 Commonwealth which are within the exclusive jurisdiction of such
- 16 agency including but not limited to regulations governing the
- 17 parking of vehicles upon such property. Whoever violates any of
- 18 the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section
- 19 governing the parking of vehicles shall, upon conviction in a
- 20 summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$5.

- 1 Whoever violates any of the rules and regulations promulgated
- 2 pursuant to this section governing the movement of traffic or
- 3 the operation of vehicles shall, upon conviction in a summary
- 4 proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$15.]
- 5 Section 2. Section 3353(a)(3) and (e) of Title 75 are
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 § 3353. Prohibitions in specified places.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Except when necessary to avoid conflict
- 9 with other traffic or to protect the safety of any person or
- 10 vehicle or in compliance with law or the directions of a police
- 11 officer or official traffic-control device, no person shall:
- 12 \* \* \*
- 13 (3) Park a vehicle:
- 14 (i) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad 15 crossing.
- 16 (ii) At any place where official signs prohibit 17 parking.
- 18 <u>(iii) At any place within the jurisdiction of a</u>
- 19 particular Commonwealth agency, including an agency with
- jurisdiction of the Capitol Complex, where official signs
- 21 <u>prohibit parking. A person who violates this subparagraph</u>
- 22 <u>commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be</u>
- 23 <u>sentenced to pay a fine equal to the fine the person</u>
- would be subject to in the municipality where the offense
- occurred. The Department of General Services shall
- annually publish a schedule of fines in the Pennsylvania
- 27 <u>Bulletin that applies to jurisdictions under this</u>
- 28 <u>subparagraph</u>.

- 30 (e) Penalty. -- [Any] Except as set forth in subsection (a) (3)

- 1 (iii), any person violating any provision of this section is
- 2 guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
- 3 sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$50.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
