## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in rules of the road in general, providing for
- prohibiting use of handheld mobile telephones.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3318. Prohibiting use of handheld mobile telephones.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), no
- 10 <u>driver shall operate a moving vehicle on a highway of this</u>
- 11 Commonwealth, which shall include a Federal, State and municipal
- 12 highway, while using a handheld mobile telephone.
- 13 (b) Exception. -- This section does not apply to law
- 14 enforcement officers and operators of emergency vehicles when on
- 15 duty and acting in their official capacities.
- 16 (c) Defense. -- It shall be a defense to an action under this
- 17 <u>section that the driver had reason to fear for the driver's</u>
- 18 safety, was reporting a traffic accident or was making a 911

- 1 emergency call.
- 2 (d) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 3 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 4 a fine of \$50.
- 5 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 6 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 7 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 "Handheld mobile telephone." A mobile telephone other than a
- 9 <u>hands-free mobile telephone with which a user engages in a call</u>
- 10 using at least one hand.
- "Hands-free mobile telephone." A mobile telephone that has
- 12 <u>an internal feature or function</u>, or that is equipped with an
- 13 <u>attachment or addition</u>, whether or not permanently part of the
- 14 mobile telephone, by which a user engages in a call without the
- 15 use of either hand, whether or not the use of either hand is
- 16 <u>necessary to activate, deactivate or initiate a function of the</u>
- 17 telephone.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
