AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in district superintendents and 5 assistant district superintendents, providing for limitation 6 on severance packages. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: 13 Section 1075.1. Limitation on Severance Packages. -- (a) If a 14 board of school directors: 15 (1) enters into a contract with a district superintendent or assistant district superintendent, as provided by this article, 16 17 after the effective date of this section; 18 (2) terminates the contract; and

(3) upon termination, pays to the district superintendent or

- 1 assistant district superintendent an amount greater than twenty-
- 2 <u>five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for all compensation,</u>
- 3 the school entity shall be subject to a fine pursuant to
- 4 <u>subsection (b).</u>
- 5 (b) The Department of Education shall fine a school district
- 6 which violated subsection (a) an amount equal to the market
- 7 value to income aid ratio of the school district multiplied by
- 8 the amount of compensation in excess of twenty-five thousand
- 9 dollars (\$25,000).
- 10 (c) For the purposes of this section, "compensation" shall
- 11 <u>include all payments for salary for the remaining term of a</u>
- 12 contract, payment for unused sick leave and vacation days,
- 13 payment of health insurance benefits and any other payment made
- 14 to or on behalf of a district superintendent or assistant
- 15 <u>district superintendent upon termination as specified by the</u>
- 16 <u>contract</u>.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
