1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for chemical testing to determine amount of alcohol or controlled substance.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1547(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 1547. Chemical testing to determine amount of alcohol or
10	controlled substance.
11	(a) General ruleAny person who drives, operates or is in
12	actual physical control of the movement of a vehicle in this
13	Commonwealth shall be deemed to have given consent to one or
14	more chemical tests of breath, blood or urine for the purpose of
15	determining the alcoholic content of blood or the presence of a
16	controlled substance if [a police officer has reasonable grounds
17	to believe the person to have been driving, operating or in
18	actual physical control of the movement of a vehicle:
19	(1) in violation of section 1543(b)(1.1) (relating to

driving while operating privilege is suspended or revoked),
3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or
controlled substance) or 3808(a)(2) (relating to illegally
operating a motor vehicle not equipped with ignition
interlock); or

6 (2) which was involved in an accident in which the 7 operator or passenger of any vehicle involved or a pedestrian 8 required treatment at a medical facility or was killed.] <u>one</u> 9 <u>of the following applies:</u>

(1) A police officer has reasonable grounds to believe 10 the person to have been driving, operating or in actual 11 physical control of the movement of a vehicle in violation of 12 section 1543(b)(1.1) (relating to driving while operating 13 14 privilege is suspended or revoked), 3802 (relating to driving 15 under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) or 3808(a)(2) (relating to illegally operating a motor vehicle 16 17 not equipped with ignition interlock). 18 (2) The person was driving, operating or in actual 19 physical control of the movement of a vehicle which was

20 involved in an accident in which the operator or passenger of

21 <u>any vehicle involved or a pedestrian required treatment at a</u>

22 <u>medical facility or was killed.</u>

Section 2. The amendment of 75 Pa.C.S. § 1547(a) shall apply to a person driving, operating or in actual physical control of the movement of a vehicle in this Commonwealth on or after the effective date of this section.

28 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
